Every morning this newsletter will be handed out during the Pit Meeting. Extras can be found in the tower. The purpose of

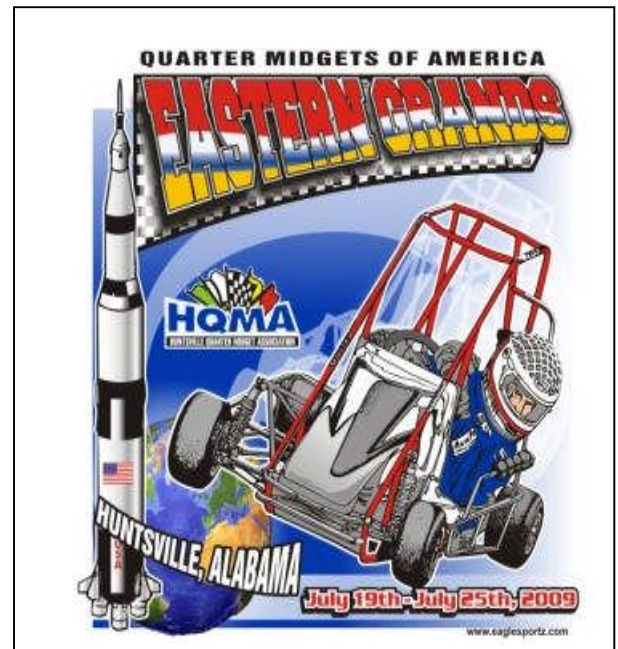
