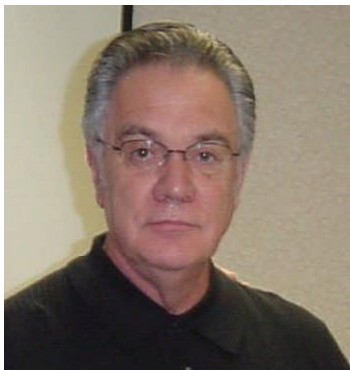
Throughout the practice rounds the Tech Committee has been at the scales to look over your cars to insure that they meet all specifications. Any issues that we brought to your attention should have been taken care before you cross the scales today. In addition to the tech inspections on the car itself, safety items will also be checked.

It is ultimately the handler's responsibility to make sure that seals for fueling and motor are done properly. Also, remember to make sure that your qualifying number is painted on the engine and the frame. Don't be afraid to ask any officials for help at any time.

Honda Motorsports has been a great supporter of Quarter Midgets of America since 1995. QMA introduced the Honda 120 cc engine at the 1995 National Meeting. The first Honda Engine hit the track early in 1996. The 120 Class quickly grew from the exhibition class to Junior, Senior, and Heavy. In 2000 QMA then adopted the 160 cc classes as we know today.

Mr. Dave King has been our representative since the beginning of the QMA/Honda partnership.

He is present at each National Meeting, as well as, at many of the Grand National events. In 2008 Mr. King was granted a lifetime membership into Quarter Midgets of America. Honda has supported all of the grands with funds exceeding \$145,000.00. This year Honda has donated 4 generators, 4 light units, and pop up tents for use at all three grands in addition to the \$3000 they have pledged for each. This year Honda will also be displaying a QMA Quarter Midget at each Nascar Race across the country beginning in late July.
