WAIVER & RELEASE DOCUMENTS PROCEDURE

1. Every person 18 years old and older who is going to enter the restricted area **MUST** sign the Waiver & Release each week and be identified in some manner (wrist band) so they can enter. (This includes alternate handlers 16 and 17 year old). Form 1155. Please check QMA ID Badges each time.
2. Every minor (under age 18) who is going to enter the restricted area, must have the 2-sided waiver signed by both parents and it must be kept on file for the full year. If both parents' signatures are not witnessed at the track, a notary public must witness them. Form 1068.
3. Upon completion of the 1068, 2-sided waiver form by both parents or notary public, the driver or child under the age of 18 must sign the 1069 form each time they enter the track or hot chute with one parent weekly. Form 1069.
4. **ALL WAIVERS MUST BE KEPT ON FILE UNTIL AT LEAST 3 YEARS AFTER THE PERSON REACHES 18 YEARS OF AGE.**

The waiver and release is your first line of defense. Please do not be lax in getting **EVERYONE** who goes into the restricted area (pits, hot chute, track) to sign the waiver.

Please see the attached sheet for exact details on how to properly fill out the waivers for minors.
