1. RCP is voted on by club membership.
2. Upon majority approval it is forwarded to Club President for signature.
3. Club President forwards to Regional Director.
4. Regional Director forwards to the National Secretary.
5. By Signature of Club President and Review by Regional Director, they are confirming that they have reviewed and followed the Rule Change Proposal Procedures as published by QMA.

7. All RCP's must be typed to be valid all hand written RCP's will be disallowed.

Grand National Timing format mandatory at States events. Format may be altered due to weather and car count, to be determined by the Regional Director present at the event.

Proposed Wording

Each region shall decide its own States race format. Format...event.
